BEST TEACHERS AWARD – 2018-19

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

NASI, Jharkhand Chapter has instituted the **Best Teachers Award** to recognize and value excellence, consistency and high level of teaching in Schools in the State of Jharkhand. The award aims to recognize and honour teachers who have provided guidance, inspiration and mentored students to take up careers in Science and Technology. The maximum number of awards is **ONE** each in pre-senior and senior category (details in the information brochure). The awardees shall receive a memento, a cash award of Rs. 10,000/- and a citation.

The nominees should be teaching or have taught in India, with at least 10 years of teaching experience in Classes VI-XII in any recognized School in the State of Jharkhand. Any teacher below the age of 55 years as on December 31, 2018 shall be eligible for being nominated

The Nomination should be essentially done by the Principal of the School where he/she is currently serving. The nominators may forward only one nomination in each category.

The **last date** of receipt of nominations is **January 28, 2019**. For further details, please refer the information brochure and nomination proforma.

INFORMATION

Scope: To recognize and value excellence, consistency and high level of teaching in the Schools in the State of Jharkhand, the NASI Jharkhand Chapter has instituted the Best Teachers Award. The award is made annually to recognize and honour teachers for providing guidance, inspiration and mentoring students to take up careers in Science and Technology.

Number of Awards: The number of awards to be made in any year shall be TWO science teachers, one from VI to VIII std. and second from IX to XII.

Eligibility:

- a)** The award shall be made to outstanding teachers currently working or worked in India, with at least 10 years of teaching experience at any recognized school in the State of Jharkhand
- b)** Maximum age limit is 55 years as on December 31, 2018.
- c)** A teacher may be nominated only by The Principal of the School where he/she is currently serving. The nominators may forward only one nomination in each category.
- d)** Only one nomination per teacher in either category will be accepted

Selection Criterion: Consistent excellence in teaching as evident from introducing novel teaching methods, experiments and models, performance of students, inspiring students to take up careers in Science and Technology. Active involvement in science popularization and outreach activities will be an additional consideration.

Announcement of the Awards: The names of the awardees selected for the award shall be notified to the applicant and Principal of the respective school.

Presentation of the Award: Awards shall be conferred on National Science Day programme, normally 28th February 2019 or else it will be intimated.

Value: Each award will carry a cash prize of Rs 10,000/ (Rupees Ten thousand only) along with a citation and a memento.

The nomination must be made in the prescribed format (*Annexure-I*).

One hard copy and a soft copy in MS-Word only, along with all supporting documents must reach on or before 28th January 2019. For soft copy the scanned version of all supporting documents must be attached in email.
