The final merit list will be prepared on the basis of the performance of the candidates in the competitive written examination. <b>Rule 10.3.2:</b> A duly constituted Selection Committee will conduct the trade test and the written test for the candidates to evaluate their suitability for the post. The syllabus for the written test will be notified separately.
